16.2.3. Identify and Engage With Local Stakeholders

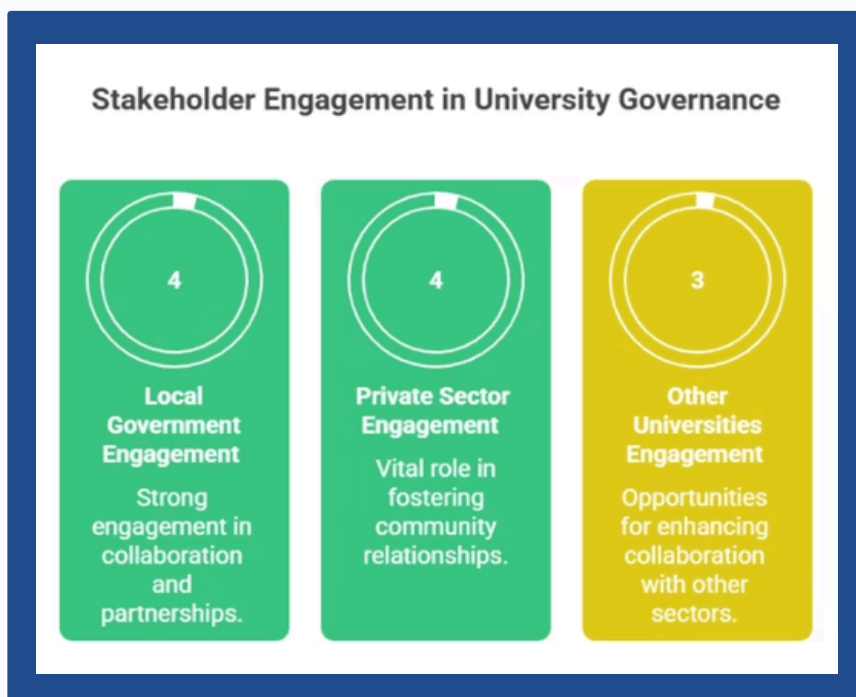
