The Four Perspectives of Measuring Ranking

Times Higher Education Impact Rankings have produced an updated, detailed methodology guide explaining how to measure universities' progress towards achieving the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**. It identifies four important perspectives:

1. Research: the kind of knowledge created by universities to address the world's problems (research output linked to **SDG** topics).

2. Stewardship: initiatives universities take to manage their own resources.

3. Outreach: the way universities interact with society through community projects and programs.

4. Education: how far the courses offered by universities are relevant to the specific **SDGs**.

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Misr International University has been named for the first time among the world's top universities according to Times Education Impact Ranking. The University ranked +601 in recognition of its effort towards achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. MIU ranked +301 for "No Poverty", 400 -301 for "Good Health and Well Being", 600 -401 for "Quality Education", 400 -301 for "Gender Equality", 300-201 for "Clean Water and Sanitation", +401 for "Reduced Inequalities", and 600 -401 for "Partnerships for the Goals".



Introduction

Last year Misr International University (MIU) was named for the first time among the universities making a positive impact on society according to Times Education Impact Ranking. While the position gained by the university was not as high as we strive, it signaled a new chapter in the history of the university. It was an achievement, a big step, and a reward for over 20 years of hard work and dedication. But most importantly, it was a responsibility. Since then, we have been trying more than ever to direct our effort towards addressing world problems. Education and research are no longer viewed as an end themselves, but as a means towards the noble end of creating a better sustainable future. Serving the community is no longer a core dimension for a higher education institution, but an ultimate target that supersedes any other one.



The University ranked +60 I in recognition of its effort towards achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. It ranked +30 I for “No Poverty”, 400 -30 I for “Good Health and Well Being”, 600 -40 I for “Quality Education”, 400 -30 I for “Gender Equality”, 300-20 I for “Clean Water and Sanitation”, +40 I for “Reduced Inequalities”, and 600 -40 I for “Partnerships for the Goals”. Such results have helped us look more carefully into certain areas either to address problematic issues or enhance our performance.



Our university is on a mission to build a sustainable society. While we remain relentlessly dedicated to teaching and research, we still believe that higher education institutions should lead by example in the pursuit of sustainability in all its activities. Therefore, we have a longstanding commitment towards several aspects related to other SDGs including fighting poverty, promoting good health, empowering women and girls, providing clean water and sanitation, fostering economic growth, combating inequalities, creating sustainable communities, and establishing global partnership. Thus, MIU endeavors extend across all SDGs, particularly SDG 1, SDG 3, SDG 4, SDG 5, SDG 6, SDG 7, SDG 8, SDG 10, SDG 11, SDG 12, SDG 16, and SDG 17.

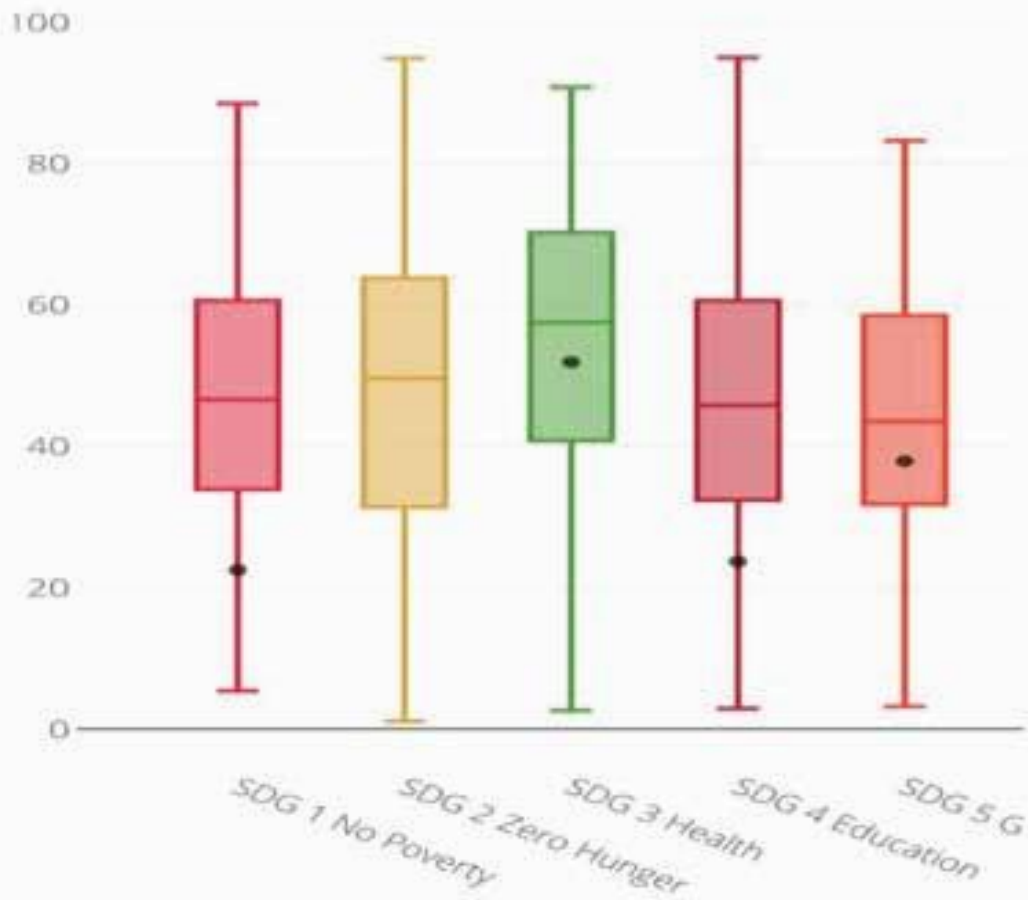

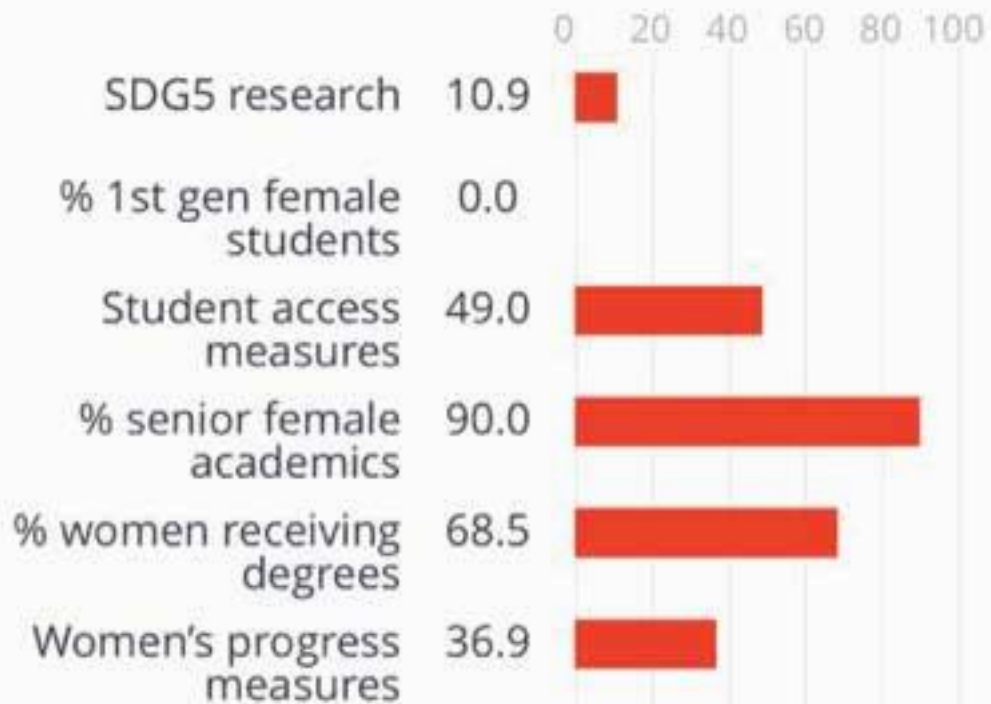

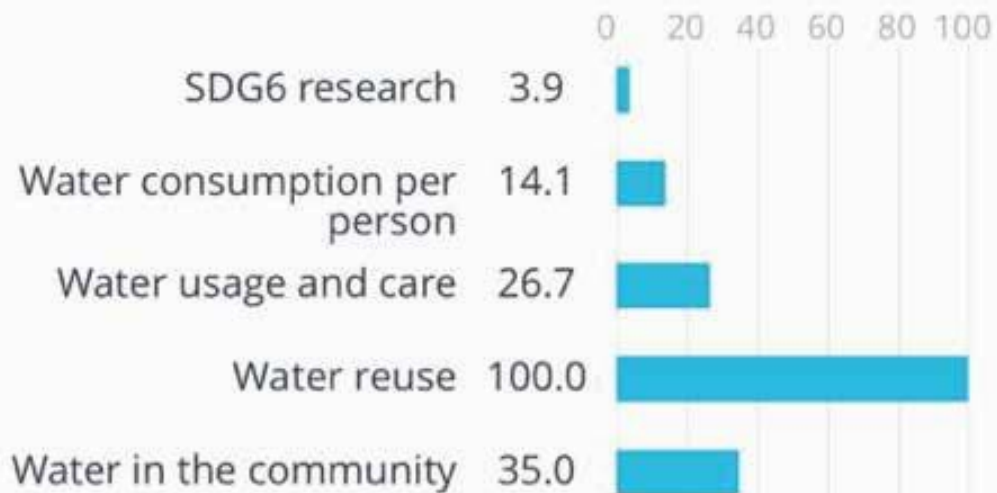

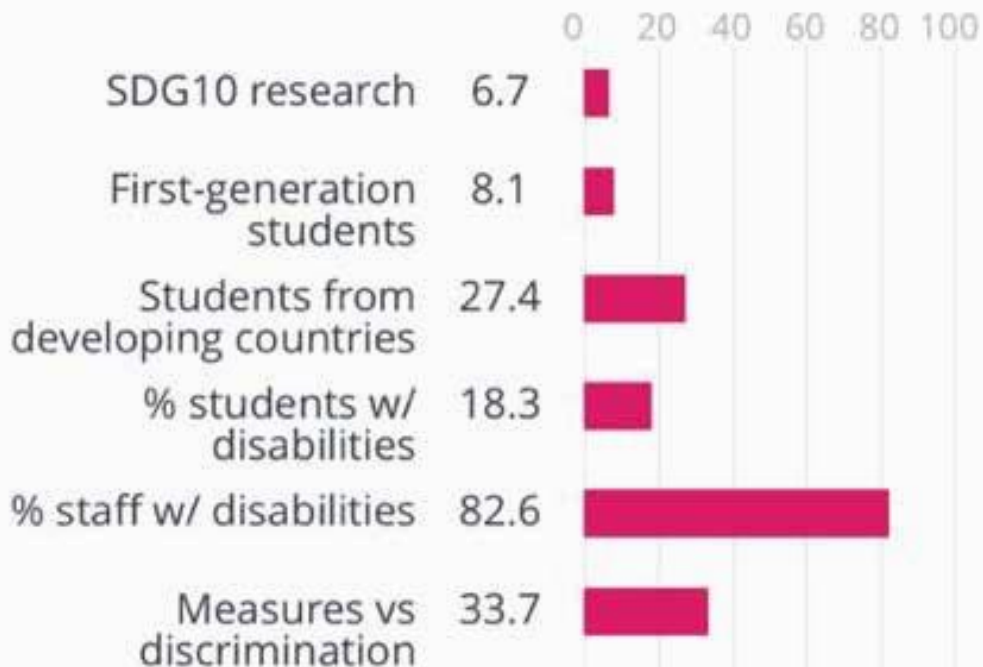

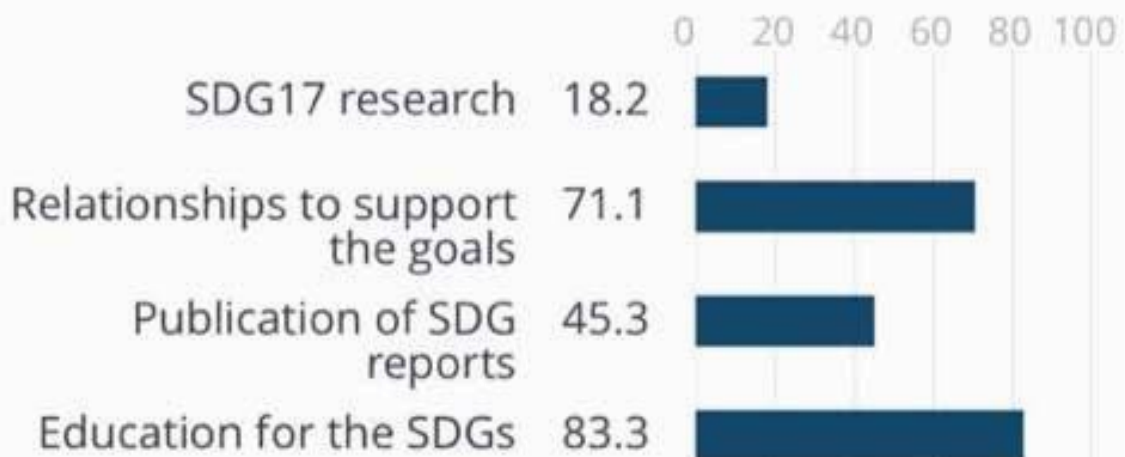

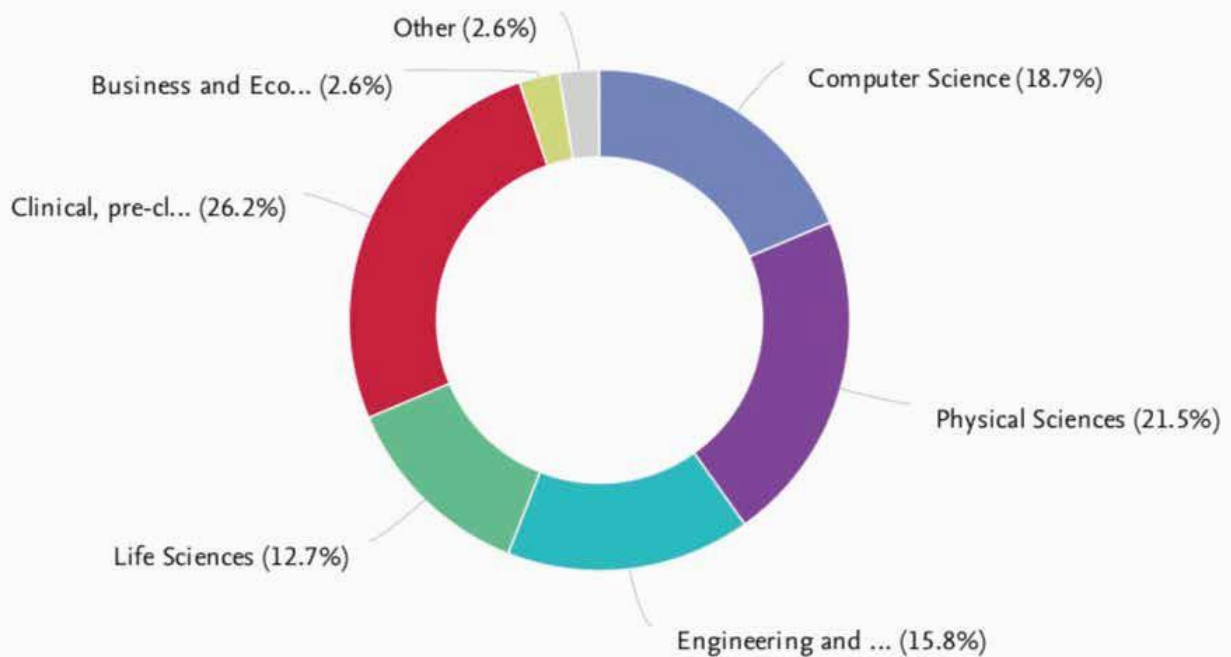

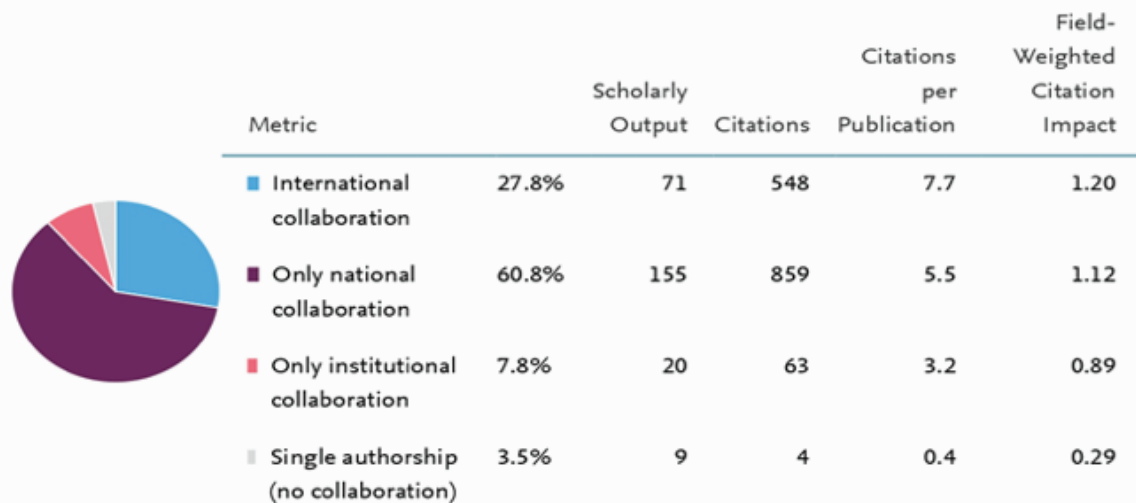

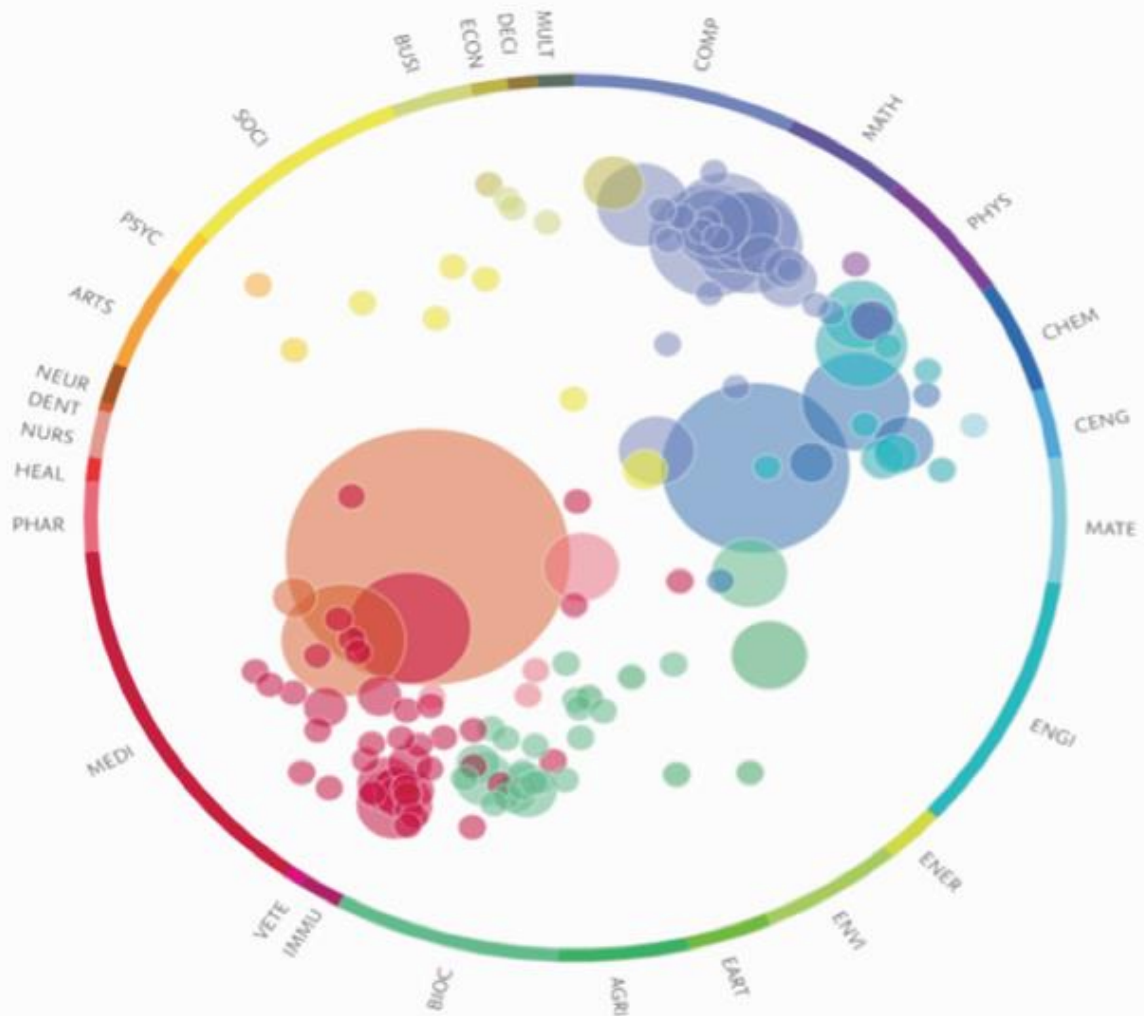

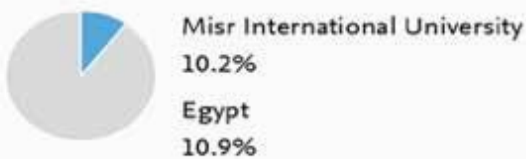

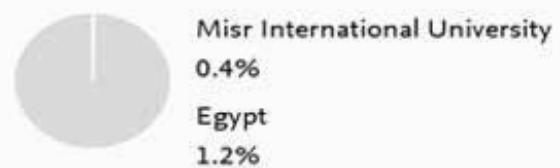

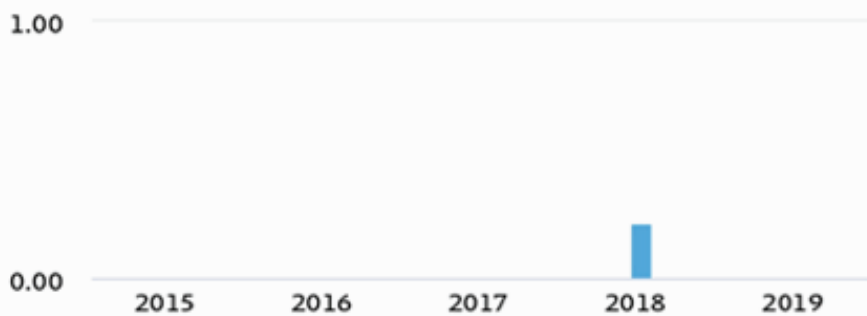

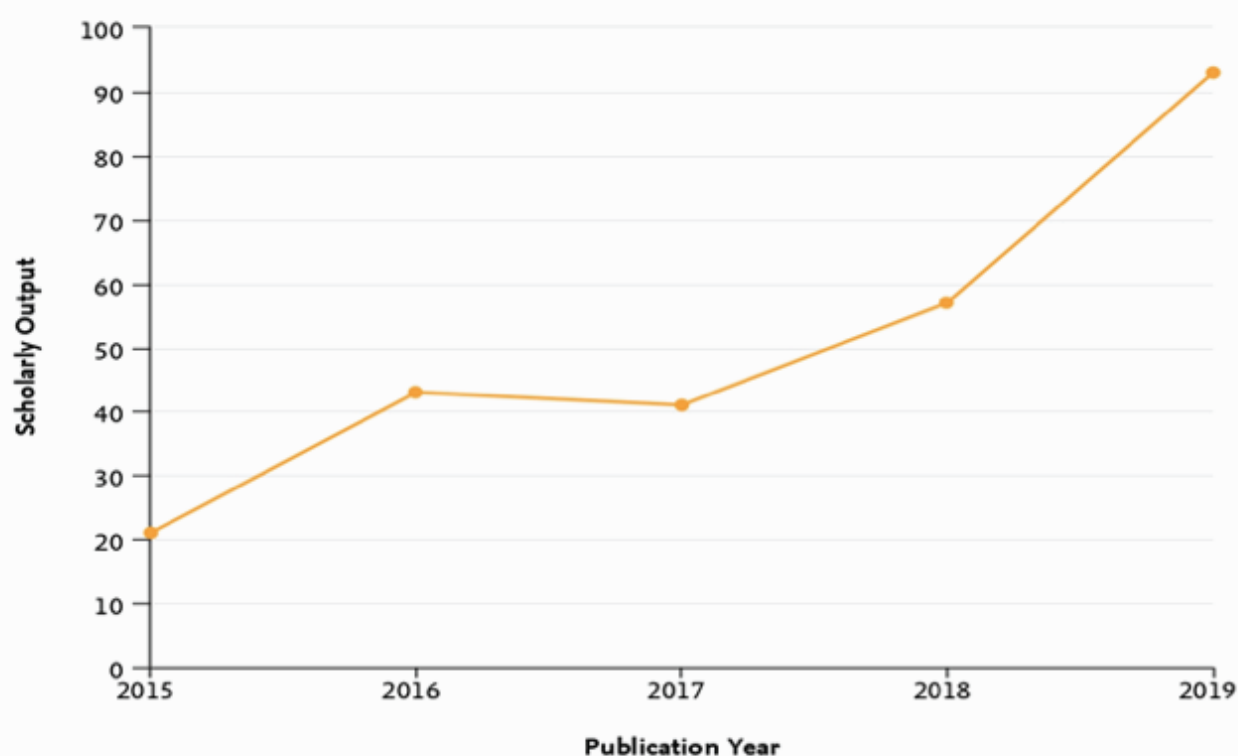

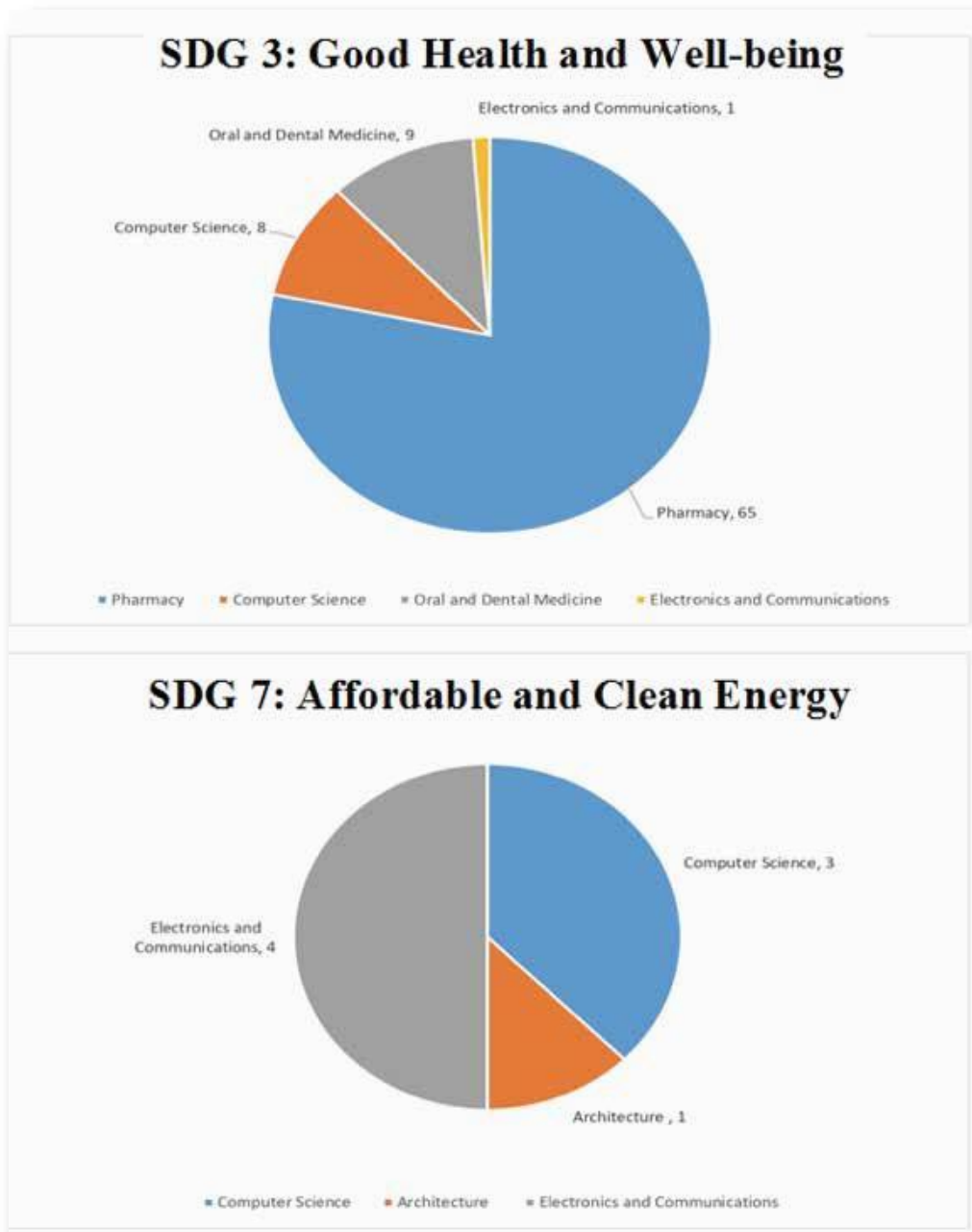

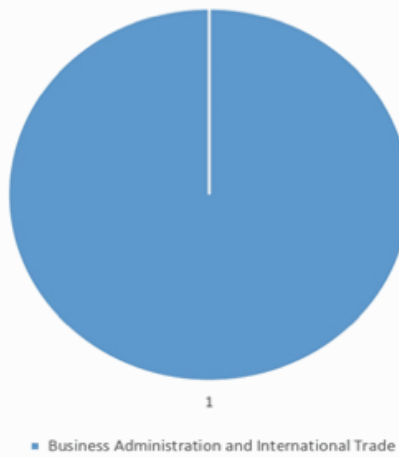

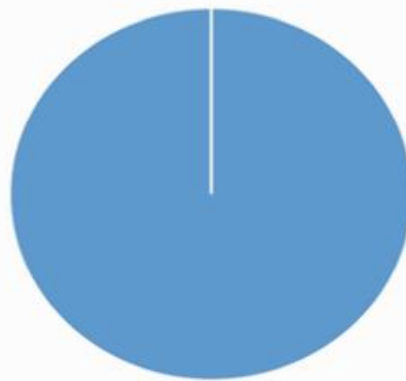

SUMMARY

The present section highlights the rigorous endeavors that MIU makes towards attaining the goals set in the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Sustainable Development Strategy (SDS): Egypt Vision 2030. The leading role taken up by MIU in this regard has been translated into a sustainable development action plan that organizes extensive effort in four main areas: research, stewardship, outreach, and education. MIU research contributions, community-oriented activities, and academic programs are all contextualized and directed to prepare graduates who leave the campus ready to engage fully in the challenges of global sustainability, and find innovative solutions to create a sustainable society and future. Believing that the SDGs adopted by the United Nations in 2015 are interconnected and are intended to address interconnected global challenges that must be equally addressed, MIU has tried during this year to advance sustainability in its academic and community-oriented practices through working on various SDGs all at the same time. The academic year 2019/2018 was a fruitful year with all-embracing academic and non-academic activities.

To begin with, the data presented show that the research contributions related to various SDGs, although is more significant compared to last year, still require further attention.

Summary(Cont.)

MIU scholarly output has witnessed a considerable increase in the number of research papers published, percentage of citations, and amount of international, national and institutional collaboration. Publications covered a wide range of subjects, mainly health and computer science. It is to be noted that one of the reasons leading to the limited research output could be the number of staff members. Therefore, the University is trying to address this issue by regularly hiring good caliber as well as offering incentives, and flexible hours for staff members to allow them more time for research.

A number of SDGs has been achieved through organizing on-campus events and launching off-campus outreach campaigns and programs. Dentistry students and interns adhered to their tradition of visiting schools and care houses to provide medical support and raise awareness about the importance of oral health. Special celebrations for orphans and people with special needs were marked at MIU, in appreciation of their courage to overcome obstacles. First aid sessions, and fire extinguishing training were also delivered to develop necessary life skills.

Summary(Cont.)

Financial support this year was offered in different forms, including planning weddings, designing programs to empower girls, and offering free courses on computer skills (MS Office) to the public. SDG4 (Quality Education) has been achieved this year side by side with SDG17 (Partnerships for the Goals). Among the key academic achievements this year are providing unique training and internship opportunities for students in leading institutions, and establishing the Center of Excellence in Translation Technology to bridge the gap between academia and industry and encourage interdisciplinary studies. SDG4 has also been met by offering courses that aim to enhance skills highly demanded in the job market such as initiating a minor for teaching English as a foreign language. To update the staff members with the latest methodologies and strategies in research and publications, a number of workshops and lectures were delivered, by professors and keynote speakers from different national and international institutions. In addition, several workshops on universities' impact rankings were organized to inform the staff of the indicators used to assess universities against the United Nations' SDGs.

Summary (Cont.)

All these contributions are made within the framework of the sustainable development action plan laid down by the university in response to UN's SDGs and SDS Egypt Vision 2030. The tables included in this report clearly show that SDG4 which is related to quality education is only one of the many SDGs that the university seeks to attain. Ending poverty (SDG1), ensuring good health (SDG3), empowering women (SDG5), allowing access to water and sanitation (SDG6), promoting economic growth (SDG8), reducing inequality (SDG10), creating safe and sustainable communities (SDG11), achieving responsible consumption of resources (SDG 12), and establishing global partnerships (SDG17) have all received equal emphasis by the university. These activities reflect the strong commitment of MIU to making a positive social impact through its research, teaching, community engagement, and partnerships.

Believing that the pursuit of sustainability is an ongoing and collective effort, Misr International University in the coming years will continue to join forces with several key players to further enhance the role of higher education institutions to reach the global goals and contribute to the welfare of humanity.

The next section lists a number of recommendations and future areas of interest that the university intends to tackle to consolidate its position and reputation internationally.

Recommendations and Future Plans

Taking last year ranking results into considerations and aspiring to gain a higher position among the world's most effective universities, the following suggestions and future plans are thought to be crucial towards achieving more SDGs and consolidating the ones already achieved by the university:

1. Establishing a research support unit with the aim of advancing MIU's research contributions, and guiding through young researchers.
2. Signing partnership and cooperation agreements with prominent organizations to fund/co-fund the university's research and scientific innovation.
3. Allowing staff members some flexibility in the working hours to give them some extra time for research work.
4. Encouraging students' research activities by establishing a student research committee, as a sub-body of the University's Research Committee. The main aim is to provide academic support and consultation for students to publish their research under the supervision of a staff member.

Recommendations and Future Plans (Cont.)

5. Enhancing quality education by incorporating technology in all aspects of the educational process, including using visual aids more effectively, offering hybrid and online courses. Relevant workshops could be organized to help staff members making the best use of technology in their classes.

6. Directing graduation projects and research-oriented courses in all faculties towards presenting practical solutions to address real-life problems.

7. Signing more partnership agreements with industry to guarantee better training and job opportunities to MIU students/graduates helping them contribute more effectively to serving the community with the knowledge and skills they have.

8. Addressing SDG2 (Zero hunger) through starting initiatives related to hunger and food security and encourage transdisciplinary research in food security and nutrition. Such effort will be directed towards helping Egyptian societies and, on the long run, African societies.

Recommendations and Future Plans (Cont)

9.Organizing workshops to brainstorm and come up with ideas of how UNSDGs can be effectively integrated into curricula across all faculties while partnering with NGOs to collaborate on solutions that address societal problems.

10.Encouraging the spirit of volunteerism among MIU community by raising awareness about the contributions of the university in this regard, and announcing events in advance to encourage staff members and students to take part in them.

11.Promoting entrepreneurship activities on campus through establishing a unit to adopt and/or sponsor students' innovations and projects (e.g. developing mobile apps or software by Computer Science students).

12.Focusing more on sustainable development goals through organizing different activities/events such as conferences, public lectures and seminars.

13.Announcing that the university is getting ready to enter the universities impact ranking race in the university board meetings and on the university website. It was announced on the 18th of March2020 (<https://www.miuegypt.edu.eg/miu-seeks-higher-international-ranking>).

Recommendations and Future Plans (Cont.)

14. Conducting further interdisciplinary and non-interdisciplinary research about SDGs and ways to achieve them.

15. Adding more practical dimensions to community service activities that go beyond financial aids. This includes teaching core and soft skills, and coming up with tech-based tools for people with special needs.

Finally, MIU pledges to focus its efforts to ensure that knowledge and science achieve their full potential for the benefit of humankind.
