Training Initiatives

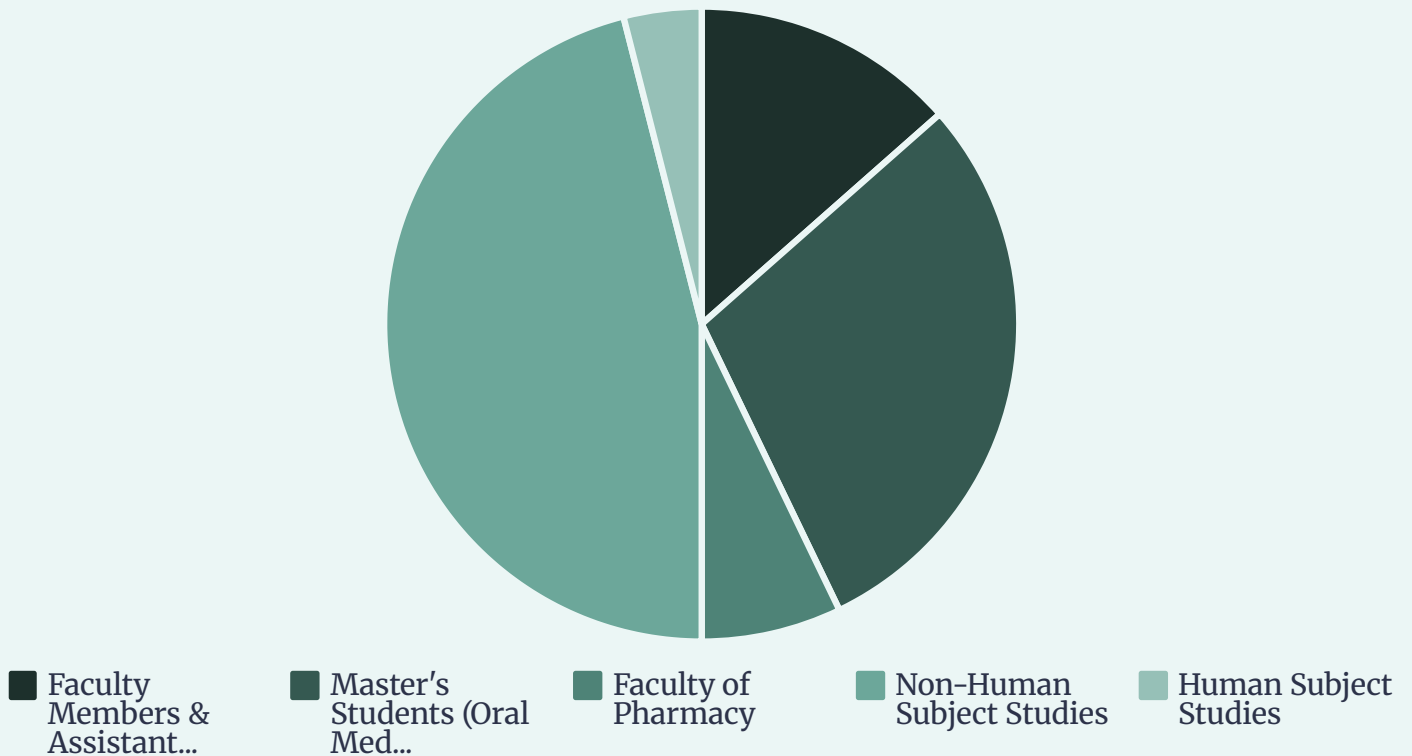

Protocol Discussions

A number of (63) protocols were discussed, including 58 studies (non-human subject) and 5 studies (human subject). These are being followed up through periodic reports until the completion of the research and the researcher's submission of the final report. The protocols were also discussed on the basis of the approved in the standard operating procedures.
